



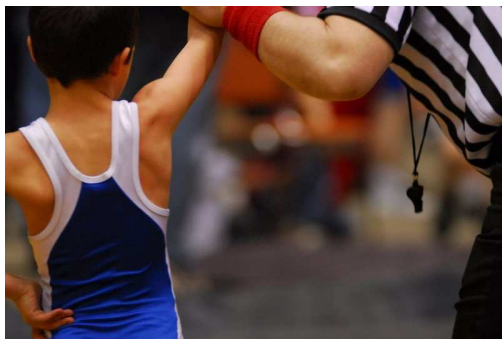

REGISTRATION

Registration for the Monarchs Wrestling Club (MWC) is open to any novice or competitive wrestler ages 4 – 14 who are not yet freshmen in high school. The cost to register is NOVICE - \$90 per (1st – 2nd year) wrestlers and OPEN \$150 per OPEN (3rd year +) wrestlers, Elite Open \$225. This cost includes a club t-shirt. Singlet's will need to be rented for \$65, upon return with no damage \$55 will be returned. There will so be a \$150 refundable parent volunteer deposit per wrestler for 12 hours of volunteer service (4 at tournament and 8 at firework tent). This deposit check will be a separate checks. Registration forms, birth certificates and fees will be filled out and turned in by the end of the first week of practice. Wrestlers will not be allowed to come to practice after the first week without forms completed and birth certificate turned in. Registration will close after the first week of practice except for anyone just moving into the area or for any Jr. High students participating in wrestling.

PRACTICE

Wrestlers need to arrive early and be ready when practice starts. Habitual tardiness will not be tolerated. All wrestlers need to check in to assure their attendance is recorded. Any wrestler not checked in within 10 minutes of the start of practice will not get credit for that practice. The club will assume any wrestler who misses two or more weeks of practice will not be returning, unless a parent informs the club otherwise. **The club will attempt one e-mail and one phone contact only. If both attempts fail, the club will assume that equipment will not be returned and your deposit check will be promptly processed.**

Shorts/Jogging pants, t-shirt with sleeves (NO CUTOFFS) and wrestling shoes or flat soled tennis shoes that are only for use in the wrestling room (no street shoes) are to be worn for practice. Wrestlers will not be allowed to practice if they do not have the proper attire. Parents will be notified of wrestlers' failure to comply with the dress code. Wrestlers need to wear pants, coats, and hats to and from practice as they get heated in the wrestling room and need to be properly protected when going back out into the cold. Parents are expected to assist their child in meeting all of their expectations at practices and tournaments. Due to the lack of room, parents are not allowed in the wrestling room and the wrestler's belongings should be placed in the stairwell next to the wrestling room. Parents should come into the building either before or after practice to assure that their wrestler has everything that they came with and to check with coaches on any changes to practices or tournaments.

TOURNAMENTS

All deadlines for entry will be the Tuesday prior to that weekend's tournament, with the exception of travel tournaments. Parents will be expected to sign their child up by the deadline – NO EXCEPTIONS other than practice cancellation, then it will be the next night of practice. This is to ensure we have enough coaches available and that we can get all of our wrestlers registered. The MWC will pay for entry fees to any tournament that the MWC attends. If you register but are unable to attend and fail to withdraw your child by the registration deadline of the tournament you will be expected to reimburse the MWC for the entry fee before your child wrestles in another MWC paid tournament. Tournaments outside of the club will be the responsibility of the parents. If the deadline for any tournament is missed, parents will still be able to register and pay for their wrestler themselves. However, parents will also need to notify the coaches of your intentions to ensure coach availability for your wrestler.

SPORTSMANSHIP/DISCIPLINE

We want every wrestler to have fun, try your best and present a good image of yourself and the club. Being a good sport is # 1. Foul language, bad attitudes, poor sportsmanship, and goofing off will not be tolerated. All wrestlers will be expected to uphold the beliefs of the club.

Problems will be handled in the following manner –

First Occurrence – wrestler dismissed from practice or tournament and parents notified.

Second Occurrence – Conference with the parent(s), wrestler and coaches to determine wrestlers' future with club.

Third Occurrence – Expulsion from club

As the wrestlers are expected to show good sportsmanship at practices and tournaments, we have those same, if not higher, expectations for our parents. Any problems with other coaches or referees will be directed to our coaches. The club expects our parents to present a good image, whether at a practice or a tournament, for themselves, their wrestlers, and the club. Parents are not allowed on the mats during a tournament, unless it is to take pictures or to video tape. As the wrestlers Mom and Dad, they will listen and look to you before us. You have us coach them all week at practice; please allow us to coach them at the tournaments. Parents will be warned about being on the mats and asked to return to the stands once in a season. If the issue arises again, disciplinary action can/will include your child not wrestling in upcoming tournament(s).

EQUIPMENT

A singlet will be issued to wrestlers after payment off \$65 is received by the club. A refund will be issued at the end of the

season for \$55 is singlet is still in usable condition. Equipment will be turned in at the End of Season Banquet and your refund check will be issued at this time. Any equipment not turned in by end of year banquet will be considered purchased and no refund check will be issued after banquet ..

VOLUNTEERING

The Fireworks Tent (June 25th thru July 4th) and the Monarchs Wrestling Club Tournament (held the Sunday after the MONARCHS H.S. DUAL TOURNAMENT) are the main fundraisers for the club and all club parents will be expected to volunteer for these events. The only exception will be parents who make arrangements to volunteer in another approved position within the club. If your volunteering obligation is not fulfilled by the time of the Fireworks Tent, your \$150 deposit check will be promptly processed. Any others who are unable to attend due to last minute issues will be handled on a case by case basis.

CLOTHING

We usually put together two clothing order per year, usually one at the beginning of the season to assure delivery by Christmas and one just after the first of the year. All clothing orders will be paid for at the time the order is placed.

ILLNESSES

Any wrestler, who is running a fever, will need to miss practice until they have been fever free for 24 hours. Any wrestler, who is on antibiotics, will need to miss practice until they have been on the medication for 24 hours. Any other infections, such as ringworm, will need to be cleared by a physician before returning to practice. These rules are for the health and safety of everyone.

MISCELLANEOUS

The club will only accept one bad check. The parents will pay for the check amount and a \$20 returned check fee, in cash. If another check is written and is returned, that parent(s) will have to pay cash for all future club expenses for the rest of the season. All the coaches and board members are volunteers and as a club we expect that they are treated with the same respect that they are expected to treat the parents and wrestlers with. Any forms that parents are to fill out **will** be filled out completely. This includes registration forms and tournament forms. All information concerning the club will be posted on the website - **www.monarchswrestlingclub.com** - it will be the parent's responsibility to be aware of the postings there. The club will send out e-mail reminders concerning upcoming tournaments and other events, but it will ultimately be up to the parents to ensure that registrations and questions are presented in a timely manner. The club will have flyers available at practices for those who do not have e-mail access.
